Tober Lastra: The Book on the "Parishes of Clogher" states: "The Survey of 1736 states "Here stands a celebrated Well called Tober Lastra, in the townland of Aghavilla, to which comes many pilgrims. It is recorded as a very good place to come to for the cure of sore eyes; some have certainly got healing there. Within living memory, large numbers of people gather at this Well on the first Sunday of May". Two female saints – St. Lastra and St. Cera are linked with Donaghmoyne Parish, almost back to the time of St. Patrick.
