Referendum: Friday 25th May, Polling from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. In his recent Pastoral Letter Rev Monsignor Joseph Mc Guinness wrote: "As human beings, we should stand up for the rights of other human beings, especially those who have no voice and no vote. As Catholics, we cannot in conscience vote for something which is directly contrary to the fundamental teaching of Jesus Christ to respect and defend the lives of all, especially the weak and the vulnerable. It is a solemn duty for each one of us to vote in this referendum. We should do so with both eyes open". The Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference has launched a website <http://www.chooselife2018.ie> with resources and prayers that will guide the Catholic faithful and all people of goodwill to an appreciation for God-given human life in these times when the dignity of human life – especially the life of the unborn child in the womb – is under attack. **The Choose Life Newsletter** promotes the Church's position on unborn human life. The Deacon: Called to Serve: On Sunday 17 June at 3pm in St Michael's Church, Enniskillen, Martin Donnelly of Enniskillen will be ordained as the first permanent deacon in our diocese since the diaconate was re-introduced by Vatican II as a 'distinct ministry of service'. All are welcome to witness Martin's ordination. **What is a Deacon:** A deacon is an ordained minister of the Church, one who serves in the parish and in the wider community. The Second Vatican Council brought forward a renewal of ministry for both lay and ordained - by our baptism we are all called to participate in the saving work of the Church. Among the wide range of ministries in the Church today is that of the permanent Deacon, a ministry that includes married men.
