Parishes of South Monaghan – Planning for the Future.

In His recent letter at all Masses on 11th August 2018, Mgr McGuinness asked the Priests in the seven Pastoral areas of the diocese to meet him. These meetings were to look at and plan for the future.

- **Provide a range of Mass times for congregations across neighbouring Parishes.**
- **Reduce the workload and stress on Priests.**
- **Provide a basis for lay people to play their full part in Ministry.**

Mgr McGuinness informed us that today, the 37 Parishes and 85 Churches in our Diocese are served by just 58 Priests, almost 50% of these over the age 65 and only 7 under the age of 50. The planning of Mass times over the five Parishes of South Monaghan allows cover during times of illness, holidays and other unforeseen absence of the Priest. The Pastoral area in South Monaghan includes the following Parishes. **Machaire Rois - Fr Larry Duffy and Fr Sean Mulligan. Killanny – Fr Michael Jordan. Inniskeen – Fr Martin Treanor. Magheraclone – Fr Philip Crowe. Donaghmoyne – Fr Michael Daly.** Fr Brendan McCague, Corduff, Raferagh and Fr Sean Nolan, Donaghmoyne will help out at weekends when available. We thank Fr Matthews Semba for his generous service within the diocese, as he prepares to return to Malawi. From the first week in September the Priests from the five Parishes in our Pastoral area will celebrate Mass in the different Churches, helping them to familiarise themselves with people and places and allowing Parishioners to know the Priest. Parish envelopes collected in any Church within the Pastoral area will be returned to their home Parish as happens at present. For all of us change is difficult.
