It is important for all of us to know that support is available to anyone in distress and for those who have experienced bereavement through suicide. If you are feeling suicidal, please know that people care and that, with support, the darkness can be lifted. Likewise, for those struggling with loss through suicide be assured that you can be supported through this difficult time. This weekend 8th/9th September, prayers for all those affected by suicide will be offered up at Masses in all parishes of the diocese. Parishes of South Monaghan – Planning for the Future.

Following on from the notice in last week's bulletin, Mgr McGuinness, having met with the priests has asked that a further letter be read at Masses this week-end 8th/9th September. The letter outlines the reasons for making changes in week-end Mass times and reducing the number of Masses in each of the seven pastoral areas in the diocese. The pastoral area of South Monaghan includes the parishes of: Machaire Rois, Killanny, Inniskeen, Magheracluone and Donaghmoyne, Mgr McGuinness has directed that from the first week-end of October 6th/7th the times of Masses in the five parishes will be co-ordinated to give people a good variety of times for Masses on both Saturday evenings and Sunday mornings. The Mass times in the five parishes from the first week-end of October will be as follows: **Vigil Masses** on Saturday evenings: Carrickmacross 6.00pm. Inniskeen 6.00pm. Lower Magheracluone 7.30pm. Donaghmoyne / Lisdoonan 7.30pm. Sunday Masses: Carrickmacross 9.30am. Inniskeen 10.00am. Upper Magheracluone 10.30am. Corduff / Raferagh 11.00am. Killanny 11.30am. Broomfield 11.30am. Carrickmacross 12.00 Noon. As you read the Mass times you will notice there is no change in the Vigil Mass in Donaghmoyne Parish on Saturday evenings which will alternate between Donaghmoyne and Lisdoonan at 7.30pm. It is on Sunday morning that change takes place, as part of the changes in our area there will be no Sunday morning Mass in either Donaghmoyne or Lisdoonan, morning Mass will be in Broomfield at the earlier time of 11.30am. The reason for this change is that I, Fr Michael Daly will be available to celebrate Mass in another church in our Pastoral area when required. Our apologies to parishioners who will be inconvenienced by this arrangement but Mgr McGuinness sees it as necessary taking account of the number and age profile of the priests. There is no question of any church in our pastoral area being closed. Each church building will continue to be central to the local community.
