Archbishop of Armagh Eamon Martin has said the Church in Ireland needs to embrace the model of engagement of Pope Francis and think seriously about a National Synod or Meeting of the Church here.

"To listen to the youth of Ireland and particularly to engage with them on what was discussed at universal level in the Church, how must that resonates with the experiences and needs of young adults in Ireland, which to me would be a very interesting synodal process" he said.
