THE CREST AND MOTTO OF OUR NEW BISHOP: Following a custom dating from the mid-twelfth century, most bishops adopt a crest or coat-of-arms. The bishop chooses elements that hold personal meaning for him in relation to his ministry, and these are combined in a display on a shield. Heraldic tradition places a stylised hat called a *galero* above the shield, shown in green, with six tassels on either side, and behind the shield a processional cross. The crest of our new bishop has three sections and three background colours. The white and

black are a reference to Fr Larry's native parish of Magheraclone while the blue denotes his association with and love of his native Monaghan. The Masai shield and the two crossed spears represent his strong links with the Diocese of Kitui in Kenya. The rowan berries and leaves are a tribute to St Macartan, the first Bishop of Clogher. The bottom part of the shield shows an image of three stained-glass windows, representing the beauty of God's light, shining through the saints. The new bishop's chosen motto is displayed below the shield - "**God is Love**".

This is taken from the First Letter of St John (I John 4:16), which reads: *'God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him.* 'These words – God is Love – express the heart of our Christian faith. They joyfully proclaim the Christian image of God: a loving God, active in our world. Love is the fundamental dimension of our relationship with God and of our lives as Christians.
