**MESSAGE FOR LENT 2019 FROM POPE FRANCIS:** Pope Francis reminds us that the celebration of the passion, death and resurrection of Christ at Easter calls us to make an annual journey of preparation, sure in the knowledge that as we are 'conformed to Christ' we have the priceless gift of God's mercy. He urges to live as children of God for the good of the whole of creation. On this St Patrick's weekend, his words are timely: 'When the love of Christ transfigures the lives of the saints in spirit, body and soul, they give praise to God. Through prayer, contemplation and art, they also include other creatures in that praise, as we see admirably expressed in the "Cantic of Creatures" by St Francis of Assisi (*Laudato Si*, no. 87).' The writings and the legacy of faith (and of place) which St Patrick has left us, also reminds us of the humble presence of the God of creation in our own time and of our solemn duty to care for all of that creation, both persons and the environment.
