## TODAY IS SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD.

This is a day set aside by Pope Francis for celebration, study, and spreading of the Word of God. Pope Francis is clear that the relationship between the Risen Lord, a community of believers, and sacred Scripture is essential to who we are as Christians. An important advance in 20th century theological reflection is that every sacramental celebration is founded and constructed upon the Word of God, and that every proclamation of the Word of God is sacramental. One of the great blessings of the liturgical reform and renewal flowing from the Second Vatican Council is a greater appreciation of the foundational role of the Word of God in every liturgical celebration and a greater awareness of the role of the Word of God in the life of faith.

**CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK:** begins today on the theme '*Catholic Schools: Living in Harmony with God's Creation*'. During Catholic Schools Week families, parishes and schools, North and South, are invited to participate in a week of celebration of Catholic schools and on their contribution to the common good of our society.
