Feast Day of St Patrick.

On Tuesday 17th March we Celebrate the Feast Day of Saint Patrick. St. Patrick is the patron saint of Ireland. Born in Roman Britain in the late 4th century, he was kidnapped at the age of 16 and taken to Ireland as a slave. He escaped but returned about 432 to convert the Irish to Christianity. By the time of his death on March 17, 461, he had established monasteries, churches, and schools. Many legends grew up around him—for example, that he drove the snakes out of Ireland and used the shamrock to explain the Trinity.

St. Patrick's Breastplate: *Christ be with me: Christ be beside me: Christ be before me: Christ be behind me: Christ be at my right hand: Christ be at my left hand: Christ be with me everywhere I go: Christ in the heart of everyone who thinks of me: Christ be my friend forever and ever. Amen.*

Corona Virus: In accordance with the norms for our diocese and parish we highlight the following:

No holy water in fonts at church doors.

No shaking of hands at sign of peace.

Holy Communion not to be received on tongue.

Collection baskets/boxes on tables at doors of each church for people to drop in their church offering. (envelope or money).

Hand sanitising gel on tables at doors of each church.

Hand sanitisers will be used by lay ministers and priests before and after distributing Holy Communion and by altar servers etc.

Only the priest receives from the chalice.

The obligation to physically attend Mass on Sundays or Holy Days has been dispensed by the Bishops at the present time. We remind people that Mass from each church at the week-end and St Patrick's Day will go out over the parish Radio as usual, the Radio wave length for each church is given at the top of the Parish Bulletin.

We continue to pray at each Mass that the spread of the Corona virus will soon cease, above all cease in our country and that it will not become present in our parish.
