Confirmation 2021. We have got word that in the present climate, the proposed schedule of Confirmations in the Diocese will not go ahead this year. Our Confirmation that was to be on Saturday 13th March with Bishop Larry Duffy is off. It is proposed that Confirmations will take place like last year, probably with smaller numbers. When Schools and Churches reopen we will look at what is feasible.

Ash Wednesday and Lent 2021. Ash Wednesday this year is on February 17th. With current restrictions we will be unable to distribute Blessed Ashes. Also with the current restrictions, which means we do not have Public Masses, we will not have the 7.30am Mass in Broomfield, Monday – Friday during Lent, instead we will continue with the 9.00am Mass each morning in Broomfield Church which will continue to be on the Parish Radio and Live Streamed.

Parish Masses: Following recent government announcements, **All Masses will be over the Parish Radio or Live Streamed only, for the present time, until a further review takes place – Week-end Masses will be celebrated in the three Churches of the Parish and will be offered for the Anniversaries that are booked as in the Parish Bulletin.
