First Holy Communion and Confirmation 2021 While we are delighted that up to 50 people are now back to Mass and other liturgies, we are disappointed that concerning these First Holy Communion & Confirmation, government advice is still the same: "It is advised that other religious ceremonies such as Communion and Confirmation should not take place at this time". With this in mind, we are asked throughout our diocese, that these Sacraments should be postponed until further notice. The very earliest that these Sacraments can be celebrated will be July. We appreciate that this will be disappointing for children, parents and families and for our teachers who do such wonderful work in preparing the children for these Sacraments. As soon as permission is given for these Sacraments to be celebrated in our Diocese, this information will be printed in the Parish Bulletin, and we will notify the Schools of the Parish.

Weddings: From 10th May, up to 50 people can attend a Wedding ceremony in Church. .

Funerals: From 10th May, up to 50 people can attend a Funeral.

Parish Envelopes.We are delighted that up to 50 people can come to Mass in any Church from Monday 10th May. So we will not have the attended Collection Box in both Donaghmoynne and Lisdoonan Churches. We invite people coming to Mass in each Church to come into the Church on the front Door and to use the Collection Box at the door-way for their Parish Envelope/Contribution.. Using the front door is important so that a check can be kept to see when the 50 people have entered. People in Broomfield or others who like to do so are welcome to drop their Envelope/Contribution into the Parish Office, Broomfield at their convenience. Sincere thanks for your generosity, which is keeping the Parish afloat in the challenging times.
