World Mission Sunday: will be celebrated today Sunday, 24th Oct. World Mission Sunday is the Holy Father's annual appeal for spiritual and financial support so that the life-giving work of overseas mission and missionaries can continue. The theme this year is '*We Cannot Remain Silent – We cannot but speak about what we have seen and heard (Acts 4:20)*'. It is a message of hope – Jesus Christ is risen; we cannot keep his love compassion, and mercy to ourselves. It also challenges us to stand up and speak out on behalf of those who are weaker. **The Collection taken up this week-end 23rd/24th October in the three Churches of the Parish will go to support Mission work, in the places where it is most needed.**

Parish Masses: We are delighted that from **Friday 22nd October, Churches can return to full capacity**, so the cords closing off every other seat will be removed in each of our Churches. While family groups can sit together, people, not of the same family are encouraged to sit a metre apart. We encourage the practice of people sitting all through Mass as they have been doing and we ask people not to kneel as a person kneeling and a person sitting in the seat in front of them would be in very close contact. Again we ask people to continue to wear face coverings for everyone's safety and to sanitise their hands going in and leaving Church. The Churches will continue to be sanitized as has been happening. It will be great to see more people at Mass, especially families and children back at Mass at the week-ends, all are welcome. In advance we thank everyone for their co-operation as we want to ensure the safety of all coming to Mass in the three Churches of the Parish.

Gluten Free Hosts: We can now provide gluten free hosts at Masses; we ask any person who is celiac or gluten intolerant and would like to receive Holy Communion to come to the priest who will give them a gluten free host.

Mass Attendance: We invite people coming to Mass in each Church to come into the Church on the front Door and to use the Collection Box at the door-way for their Parish Envelope/Contribution. People in Broomfield or others who like to do so are welcome to drop their Envelope/Contribution into the Parish Office, Broomfield at their convenience. Sincere thanks for your generosity, which is keeping the Parish afloat in the challenging times.

Broomfield New Cemetery: During the past week the evergreen trees around the Cemetery have been removed. There is a wall surrounding the Cemetery on three sides.
