Ceremony of Light for Faithful Departed.

The Annual Candlelit Ceremony will take place in Broomfield Church Sunday **28th November at 5.00pm.** Those who have lost a loved one, whose funeral took place in the Parish during the past year, are invited to bring a lighted candle to the Altar in memory of their loved one. Others who would like to take up a candle in memory of a loved one can do so afterwards. Candles will be provided. We encourage those who have lost a loved one during the past year to sit in the main aisle of the Church, near the front, as we hope to project the names of those loved ones onto the two walls on either side of the Tabernacle in the Church, as their names are read out. The Ceremony can be heard over the Parish Radio or Live Streamed from Broomfield Church. All are Welcome in Broomfield Church. Sadly with the current state of the pandemic in our country, it would not be safe to have the tea afterwards in Broomfield Hall, as happened in previous years.

Gone Only from Sight.

I am standing on the seashore. Suddenly a ship at my side spreads her white sails to the morning breeze, and starts out for the blue ocean. She is an object of beauty and strength, and I stand and watch her until at length she is only a ribbon of white cloud just above where sea and sky mingle with each other. Then someone at my side says, 'There! She's gone!' Gone where? Gone from my sight – that is all. She is just as large in mast and hull and spar as she was when she left my side, and just as able to bear her load of living freight to the place of destination. Her diminished size is in me, not in her, and just at the moment when someone at my side says, 'There! She's gone!' there are other voices ready to take the glad shout, 'There! She comes!' And that is dying.
