First Holy Communion and Confirmation In light of advice received from the Public Health Agencies resulting from their understanding of the extreme contagious nature of the Delta variant of Covid 19 and following consultation with relevant stakeholders, Bishop Larry Duffy has decided that the celebrations of the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation should not take place in the parishes of the diocese in the Republic of Ireland at this time. We acknowledge the sense of disappointment and frustration that many people are experiencing as a result of this decision, children, their parents and families, teachers and priests, but we accept that in the interests of the common good and out of concern for the well-being of the faithful that these celebrations should be deferred until such time as we can determine that it is safe to do so. As Archbishop Eamon Martin, Armagh and many others have said, the manner in which this whole matter has been handled by those in government has been very disrespectful to all concerned
