The Irish Council of Churches and Irish Inter-Church Meeting will be holding a joint service of worship in St. Anne's Cathedral, Belfast on Sunday 22nd January 2023 at 3.30pm to which all are invited.

The purpose is to celebrate the Centenary of the founding of the Irish Council of Churches – one of the world's oldest national representative church bodies – whose first meeting took place on 23rd January 1923. The service will also celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Ballymascanlon Talks which led to the establishment of the Irish Inter-Church Meeting, through which the ICC engages with the Roman Catholic Church in Ireland.

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity Begins next Wednesday 18 January and continues until 25 January.

The theme this year is "Belonging: Praying for Unity amidst Injustice". Here in Ireland, this year of 2023 marks the centenary of the formation of the Irish Council of Churches and the 50th anniversary of the Ballymascanlon Talks in 1973 which led to the formation of the Irish Inter-Church Meeting. Today, these bodies for inter-church dialogue in Ireland enable Christians to pray and work together for peace, reconciliation and social justice throughout Ireland.

Catholic Schools Week: Will begin next weekend and runs until Sunday **29 January**. The theme this year is connected to the process of Synodality, with its three features being identified as helpful to exploring 'Walking Together in Faith & Love': Communion, Participation and Mission. Synodal Pathway: The document for the European stage of the Synod was published recently and is available on www.clogherdiocese.ie and www.synod.ie. The next stage will be a European Synod in Prague in February 2023, leading to a 2-session Synod in Rome in October 2023 and October 2024. This will be alongside and informing our own Synodal Pathway here in Ireland.
